JUDGMENT ENTRY EXTENDING EMERGENCY GUARDIANSHIP

This matter came on to be heard this _____ day of _____, 20__, upon hearing upon the application of _____ to continue the emergency guardianship of _____.

Emergency guardianship was granted _____, 20__, and _____ was appointed emergency guardian of the person of _____ for a period of seventy-two (72) hours. The Court having been fully advised in the premises hereby finds that said emergency guardianship should be extended for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, and that the guardian shall have the authority to do the following, pending the filing of a regular guardianship application:

1. To give informed consent for necessary and reasonable medical treatment of the ward as per the Letters of Emergency Guardianship issued herewith;
2. To supervise the care and maintenance of the ward; and
3. To exercise all the powers and authority conferred by law upon guardians of the person and/or estate.
